The **process** and policy of **taking admissions** under sixth and seventh Cut-Off will be as **adopted** in the earlier **five** Cut-Offs,

Guidelines for students **applying** for Special Cut-Off

- 1) Following applicants will be eligible/ not eligible to participate in the Special Cut-Off
  - a) Only those applicants will be considered who could not/ did not take admission in the initial five Cut-Offs for whatsoever reasons.
  - b) An applicant who has cancelled his/ her admission in the 5<sup>th</sup> Cut-Off will not be eligible to participate in the special Cut-Off.
  - c) Applicants who are already admitted (including NCWEB) in any coursed college of University of Delhi will not be eligible to participate in the special Cut-Off.
- 2) Applicants will apply to a single college + course, Applicants must ensure that they have carefully checked the number of seats vacant in the course in college they are applying to under their category.
- 3) The Cut-Off for various courses available under each category for a college who would be admiring students under Special Cut-Off will be available on the website of University of Delhi on 23<sup>rd</sup> Nov 2020 (Mon).
- 4) In case the number of applicants applying for a particular course in a college is more than the number of seats available, colleges will make a merit as per the Best of Four/ Best of three required for the course. The college will approve only those number of applicants as per the merit, as the number of seats available.
- 5) In case of a tie for a seat the following tie-breaking rule shall be applied
  - a) The applicant with higher percentage of marks (aggregate of best five subjects including one language) in the qualifying examination will be considered first for admission,
  - b) The applicant with the earlier date of birth (as mentioned in class X certificate) will be considered for admission. }
- 6) Merely applying under the Special Cut-Off does not guarantee an admission to the applicant.
- 7) No **grievances** will be entertained in case an applicant fails to apply or pay the fees (if approved) within the stipulated time period **given** in the **schedule**.

All applicants who are admitted to any course (payment is done) are hereby notified to not to cancel their admission after the notification of the Press Release. The applicants who cancel their admissions after the closure of the 5<sup>th</sup> Cut-Off will not be considered for the Special Cut-Off. This is in accordance with the guidelines published in the Bulletin of Information for UG that **there will be no movement allowed during the Special Cut-Off.**

**University of Delhi has announced the admissions through Special Cut-Off and further Cut-Offs vide its Press release dated 21st Nov 2020**

**1) Colleges to upload the Cut-Off on the portal by 1:00 pm of 23rd Nov 2020 (Monday). As mentioned in the bulletin** the cut-off for the Special Cut-Off admissions will be the last cut-off declared by the college for a particular course. That is, if a college had declared 3rd cut-off for a particular course and no further cut-off was declared thereafter, and there are vacant seats after the University has completed the 5th round of cut-off, the Special Cut-Off for this particular course of the College will be that as declared in the 3rd cut-off.

2) **As per the notifications all students who are already admitted in any course (payment has been done) will not be considered for admission in the Special Cut-Off as movement is not allowed in the Special Cut-Off.**

3) **Applicants who cancel their 5th Cut-Off admissions or after the announcement of the special Cut-Off will also not be considered for admission in the special Cut-Off.**

4) The colleges must wait for the interested applicants to apply (till 25th Nov 2020) before approving the final shortlisted applicants. However it is advised that all other formalities like verification of documents may be completed to accelerate the process.

5) The other cut-offs (sixth and seventh if required) will be as before. Colleges would have to upload the cut-offs on the portal on 28th Nov (Saturday) and 5th Dec (Saturday) respectively.
