As you may be aware, Unified Mobile Application for New-age Governance (UMANG) is an initiative of Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology to fast track mobile governance in country by building a common, unified platform/application that provides single point access of major government services through mobile. UMANG was dedicated to the nation by Hon'ble Prime Minister, on 23rd November 2017. UMANG has also been accorded the 'Best M Government' service award from UAE Government during World Government Summit in February 2018.

Till date, UMANG has more than 6 million downloads and offers 225 services from 39 departments and 11 States. UMANG mobile application can be downloaded by giving a miss call on 97183-97183. It is also available on web – <http://www.umang.gov.in>.

Keeping in view the needs of the student community, some of the major services currently available on UMANG are as follows:

- AICTE approve technical institutes/courses, National Scholarship portal, e-pathshala and CBSE related services and other State Govt. Services viz. Birth, caste/income certificate etc.
- Hospital Booking (ORS) and blood availability
- Public Grievance Services – CPGRAMS
- PAN & Income Tax Payment
- National Pension Scheme (NPS)
- Utility Bill payments (BBPS – about 80 billers)
- Employee Provident Fund and Lost & Found (at airport/metro) service of CISF.

It is desired that young student community may be encouraged to use UMANG mobile app to avail government services and to give the feedback. UMANG mobile application is available on Android, iOS and Windows app stores.

It is requested that you may circulate this amongst all of your students and encourage them to take advantage of government services delivery through mobile.
