**RULES REGARDING THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS OF THE OFFICE
BEARERS OF THE COLLEGE OF VOCATIONAL STUDIES STUDENTS'
UNION FOR THE YEAR 2017-2018**

Following rules, terms, conditions and "Code of Conduct" issued by the University of Delhi will be strictly adhered for contesting the Students' Union election of the College.

1. Only **3rd year** students shall be eligible to contest for the post of President.
2. The post of Joint Secretary is open only to **1st year** students.
3. Candidates must have obtained **50% marks** in the last examination i.e. the examination held immediately before contesting the election. However the 50% marks criteria will **not** be applicable for the post of Central Councilor (CC) as these are as per DUSU Rules/Constitution. The candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election.
4. The candidate should have attained the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the university or **75 percent attendance**, whichever is higher.
5. The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office-bearer, and two opportunities to contest for the post of an executive member.
6. The candidate shall not have a previous criminal record, that is to say he should not have been tried and / or convicted of any criminal offence or misdemeanour. The candidate shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the university authorities.
7. The candidate must be a regular, full-time student of the College/University and should not be a distance/proximate education student. That is to say that all eligible candidates must be enrolled in a full-time course, the course duration being at least one year.
8. Nomination forms shall be available for Rs. 50/-. The money collected shall go to Union Fund.
9. Candidates for the post of President are required to deposit Rs. 200/- as security (Refundable). Candidates for all other posts are required to deposit Rs. 100/- as security.
10. Security has to be deposited with Mr. Punit Kumar, S.O. (Admn.), Room No. 39 on Tuesday 5th September 2017 till 3.00 p.m., failing which their names shall stand automatically withdrawn.
11. The Security deposit shall be forfeited in case a candidate fails to get at least 10% of the total valid votes cast for the post.
12. A candidate withdrawing his/her candidature before the last date fixed for such withdrawal may claim the return of security deposit in person by showing his/her identity card from Mr. Punit Kumar, S.O. (Admn.) Room No. 39.

NOTICE

All candidates are advised to strictly follow the rules for conduct of elections under chapter VIII clause 24 of the DUSU constitution. Students are advised to particularly note the following rules and guidelines to be observed during the pre-election period.

Failure to observe these rules shall attract stringent action and the candidate shall be debarred from contesting the elections. This may be treated as **the last warning.**

1. The students are not allowed to deface the property of the College with posters / banners / stickers or any such items put up anywhere on College premises.
2. The person whose posters / banners / stickers or any such items are found pasted will be held responsible for it and action will be taken against such person. No excuse will be entertained.
3. Teachers are requested to leave their class 5 minutes early or begin 5 minutes late to allow candidates 10 minutes in all to campaign if so desired by a particular candidate.
4. Candidates shall use common sense and basic good manners while interacting with teachers, office administration and fellow students.
5. No campaigning shall take place from 11th September 2017 onwards.
6. No candidate shall be permitted to make use of printed posters, printed pamphlet, or any other printed material for the purpose of canvassing. Candidates may only utilize handmade posters for the purpose of canvassing, provided that such handmade posters are procured within the expenditure limit of Rs. 5,000/-.
