4. OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) Certificate (in the name of the Applicant) issued by the competent authority, and wherein the caste is in the OBC central list issued by <http://ncbc.nic.in>. **Income certificate for the financial year 2019-20, dated on or after March 31, 2020, as stipulated, will be required.** The format of the OBC certificate is as per the DOPT certificate issued in 2014. 5. EWS Certificate (Appendix V) from competent authority certifying the applicant can claim reservation under this category. **Income certificate is required.**
