## **Webinar on Building Back Better: The Economic Stimulus** **By Ms. Sanjana Kadyan and Dr. Avanindra Nath Thakur**

Ms. Sanjana Kadyan, assistant director in Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, IES and Dr. Avanindra Nath, Associate Professor, OP Jindal Global University were the guest speakers for the webinar. Ms. Sanjana Kadyan gave a brief explanation of the dilemma faced by the government while formulating policies in the lockdown period. ## **Impact of Covid-19 on Unemployment and the Revival Strategy By Ms.Mitali Nikore**

Econox, the Department of Economics of College of Vocational Studies organized webinar on the topic of 'Impact of Covid-19 on Employment and the Revival strategy' on August 31, 2020.

The guest speaker for the webinar was Ms. Mitali Nikore, a consultant with Asian Development Bank and World Bank; Founder, Nikore Associates who explained the on-going trends of employment in the country and the impact that the pandemic has over it through a detailed presentation consisting of various graphs, pie charts, etc. which depicted and interestingly explained the employment patterns, demographics, and their respective causes pre and post the COVID period. She also explained the measures taken by the government to mitigate the losses in jobs caused by the pandemic and even went on to discuss some future steps that the government can take to resolve the issue.

The webinar ended on a positive note with the speaker answering some of the doubts of the attendees which cleared the uncertainties and misconceptions that they had in their mind

regarding the future of employment in different sectors of our economy and how the government is working to pull out the economy from an employment crisis.

ECONOX also conducted a survey based activity to know about the perceptions of people on the impact of covid-19 on employment and was successful in putting forward a compiled and analysed result of the activity in front of the attendees of the webinar to give them a brief overview of different opinions that people had regarding this topic.

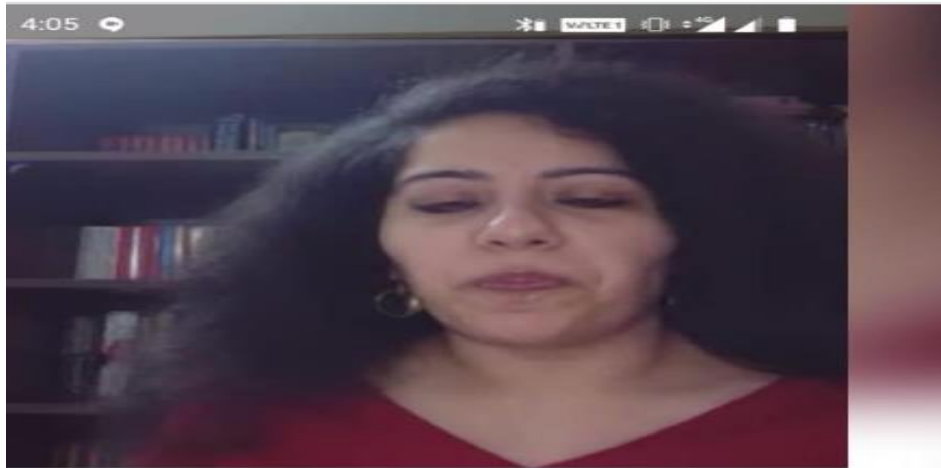

Companies need capital for operations. They can:

1. Borrow from a bank. But they need to pay interest
2. Issue debentures or bonds. They still have to pay interest. No ownership is shared
3. Issue equity, or ownership in company in return of investment. No interest needs to be paid

That's what a stock is:

1. Part ownership in the company
2. Profits to be shared with shareholders in proportion to shareholding
3. Shareholders get lower priority than bond holders in case of insolvency
