Dream Awards 2020 by CDF India

- 1. Dream Team of the Season, 2nd Runner up
- 2. Dream Project of the Season-Project Phulwari, 1st Runner up
- 3. Dream Campaign for Social Awareness- Project Aashayein

The team started two flagship Projects in the year 2019-20.

- ➤ Project Phulwari, the essence of Paradise- A product that has been started with the ultimate goal of creating dynamic and multi-professional WOMENPRENEURS. The project aims to empower 4 women by giving them an opportunity to make an extra income for their families alongside being homemakers. This Project is based on ZERO WASTE PRODUCT made out of flowers that have dried out and considered waste. The resulting product is an Organic Potpourri which is used as a room fragrant often known to smell a room with its divine aroma.
- ➤ Project Aashayein, Acid on Face not on dreams- This project has been started in collaboration with Chhanv Foundation, a PAN India Organization working for the rehabilitation of Acid Attack Survivors. The Project aims to empower acid attack survivors by helping them in enhancing their talents & skills through various online & offline training sessions.
- ➤ Project Kilkari- The project with the mission to impact underprivileged children by providing quality education to them. Our volunteers have been teaching them every Monday-Friday for the entire year. .
