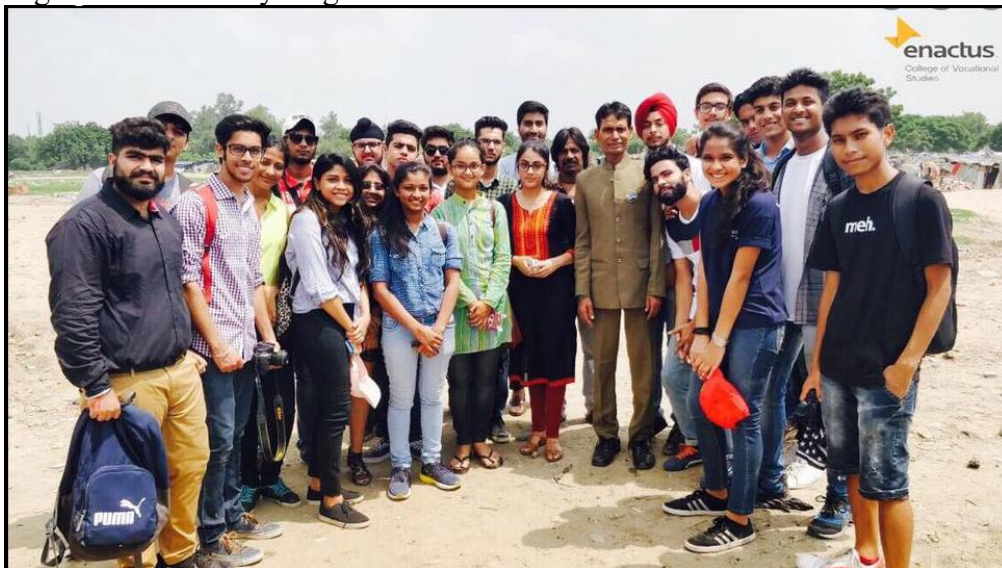
MAGIC SHOWS UNDER PROJECT MADARI

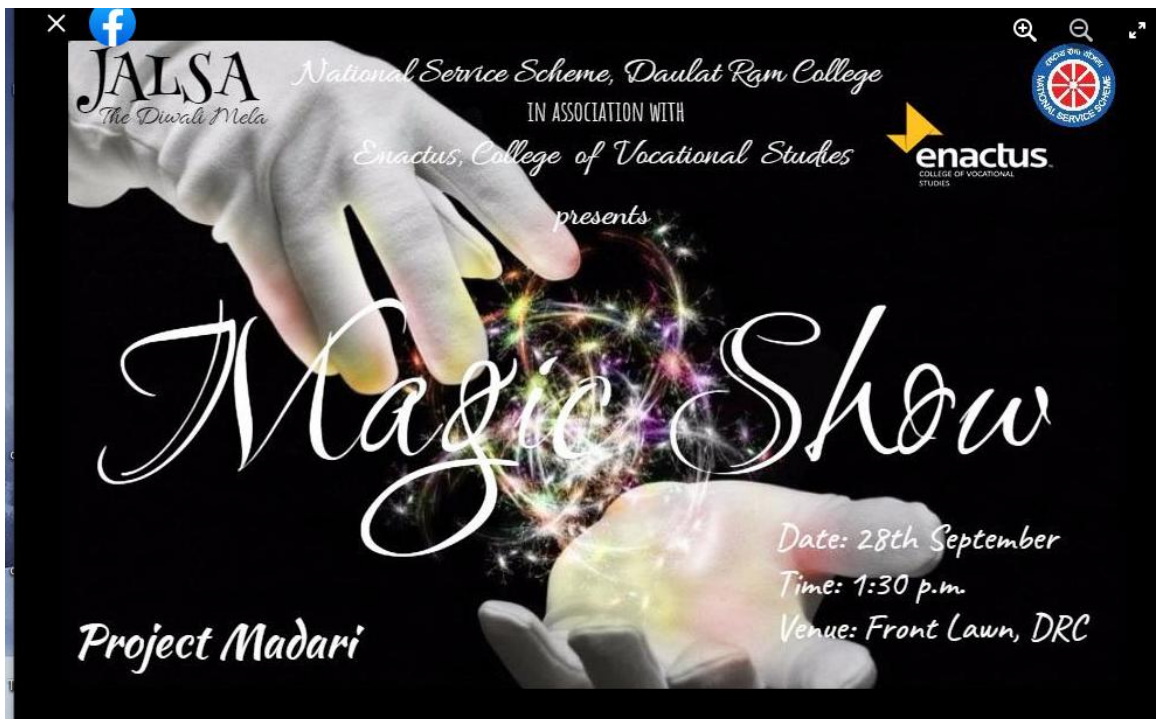
Magic Show at Zistatva (Diwali Fate of Gargi College), Dilli Haat and Faridabad

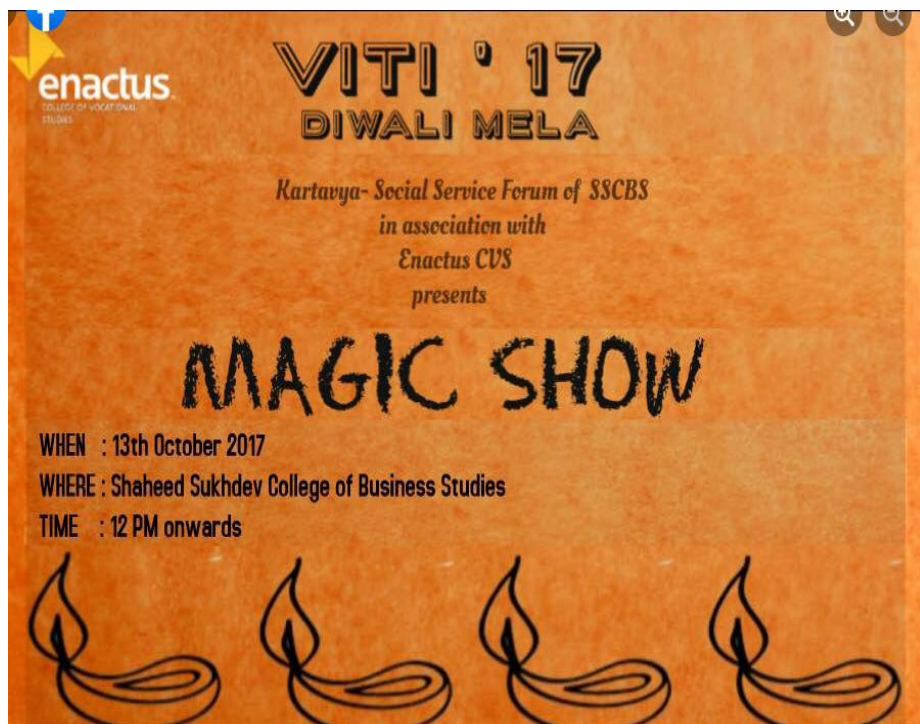
