





He was commissioned in the infantry (Sikh regiment) in 1979 and held some critical appointments in the Army, including the command of the Manipur-based Red Shield Division. He is an awardee of the Sena Medal and the Vishist Sena Medal. He also earned the battle performance report during Operation Vijay. It was a great session for our 65 cadets who participated in it and learned from respected Major General (Rtd.) K. K Sinha.

## **REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION**




## VARUNAM' 19 ( NCC FEST OF CVS )



## **PARASAILING**


Parasailing is conducted by the NCC Directorates giving cadets the thrill and experience of this adventure activity. Para Basic Course. Every year 40 boy & 40 girl cadets attend Para Basic Course at Para Training School, Agra for a duration of 24 days. In this course, you are entitled to 3 jumps during the daytime, and if time permits, you will do all the 5 jumps (including one-night jump and one with equipment). The camp lasts for about a month. The initial days are to train and build the stamina and confidence of cadets to make the jumps.


