RULES REGARDING THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS OF THE COLLEGE OF VOCATIONAL STUDIES STUDENTS' <u>UNION FOR THE YEAR 2023-2024</u>

Following rules, terms, conditions and "Code of Conduct" issued by the University of Delhi will be strictly adhered for contesting the Students' Union election of the College.

- 1. Only 3rd year students shall be eligible to contest for the post of President.
- 2. The post of Joint Secretary is open only to 1st year students.
- 3. Candidates must have obtained **50% marks** in the last examination i.e. the examination held immediately before contesting the election. However the 50% marks criteria will **not** be applicable for the post of Central Councilor (CC) as these are as per DUSU Rules/Constitution. The candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election.
- 4. The candidate should have attained the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the university or **75 percent attendance**, whichever is higher.
- The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office-bearer, and two opportunities to contest for the post of an executive member.
- 6. The candidate shall not have a previous criminal record, that is to say he should not have been tried and / or convicted of any criminal offence or misdemeanour. The candidate shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the university authorities.
- 7. The candidate must be a regular, full-time student of the College/University and should not be a distance/proximate education student. That is to say that all eligible candidates must be enrolled in a full-time course, the course duration being at least one year.
- 8. Candidates for the post of President are required to deposit Rs. 200/- as security (Refundable). Candidates for all other posts are required to deposit Rs. 100/- as security.
- 9. The Security deposit shall be forfeited in case a candidate fails to get at least 10% of the total valid votes cast for the post.
- 10.A candidate withdrawing his/her candidature before the last date fixed for such withdrawal may claim the return of security deposit in person by showing his/her identity card from Mr. Manoj Kumar Sharma, A.O. (Admn.) Room No. 6.
