The food walk provided an enriching experience to the Rotaractors as they could interact, explore and enjoy through this fun event.


## **Report of the Event:**

## **Report of the Event:**



## **Report of the Event:**



Rotaract Club Of College Of Vocational Studies initiated project PARAMARSH, a chance to interact and educate NGO students on the account of Literacy day.




It was organised on 17 September 2022 in Sanjay Van Park .
