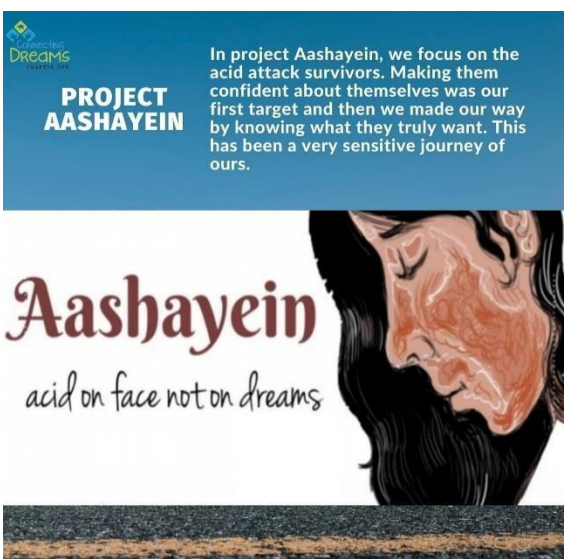

### **AASHAYEIN INTERVIEW SERIES WITH ACID ATTACK SURVIVORS**

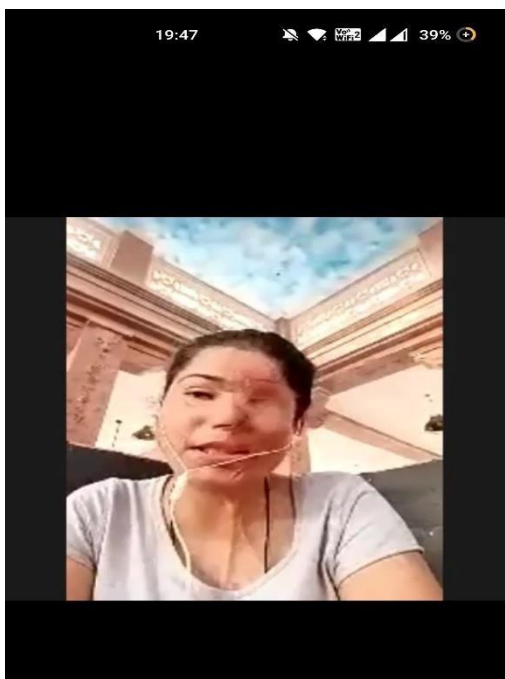

All these survivors work conjointly in Sheroes Hangout Café- a café managed entirely by acid attack survivors. 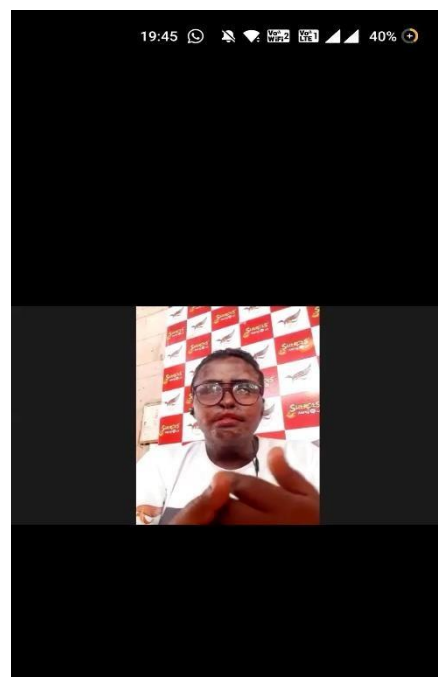

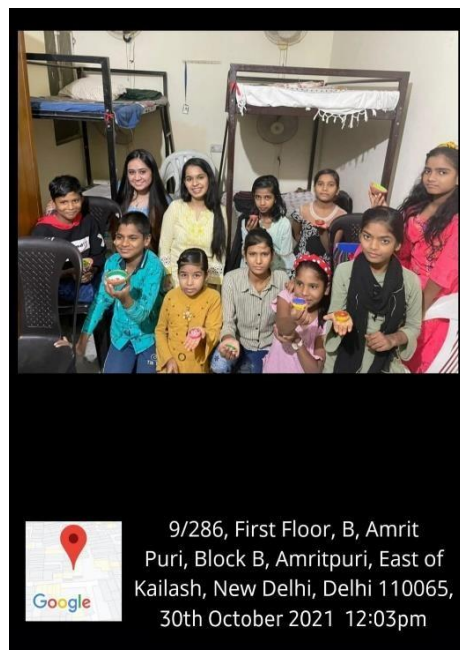
## DIWALI EVENT AT HUMANITY FOUNDATION (NGO)




