On analyzing the survey, it is observed that the students are very satisfied with the coverage of syllabus in the classroom. Students' appreciate the fact that their performance in assignments/presentations is discussed with them and teachers inform them about expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes. Teachers identify students' strengths and encourage them in providing right level of challenges. The college/teachers use student centric methods such as experimental learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences. Students' are satisfied about the fact that the teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities. Students are satisfied by the efforts that are made by college/teachers to inculcate soft skills/ life skills and employability skills to make students ready for the world of work. The teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates students in cognitive, social and emotional growth and students are pretty satisfied by the same.

Some students have expressed concerns regarding college infrastructure and the usage of ICT tools by teachers. Since the college was completely shut during pandemic, there is a need to rework on the infrastructure and other facilities. The college has already initiated the process to revive the same. Considering the feedback received by the students, the college is making efforts to encourage the faculty to make an extensive usage of ICT tools.
