





**QUONSULT:** THE CONSULTING SOCIETY OF THE COLLEGE OF VOCATIONAL STUDIES HAS ORGANISED THE FIRST-EVER OFFLINE EDITION OF THE ANNUAL FEST "**QUALIBER**" ON THE **11TH AND 12TH OF JANUARY 2023**. OVER **700 STUDENTS** FROM VARIOUS COLLEGES ACROSS THE COUNTRY TOOK PART IN THE EVENT.

The competition was divided into two sub-events:

- 1.Case-a-Way: A Case Study Competition
- 2. Fun Fiesta: A fun event.

The ideal balance of amusement and learning enabled the participants to improve their problem-solving, entrepreneurship, and business sense.

#### Case-a-Way: A Case Study Competition

Case competitions are an excellent way to improve the skill set among youngsters, participants gain academic, problem-solving, and presentation experience while getting the chance to network, travel, and even win prizes. Keeping that in mind, case a way: the case study competition was organized in full swing in both online as well as offline mode. The event consisted of three rounds.

- **Prelims**: the preliminary round was conducted online mode on 2nd January 2023. Nearly, **630 students** participated in this round, which was aimed to test their knowledge of business, Finance & Economics related issues.
- Round 1: out of 630+ participants, around 40 teams have been selected for the first round which was conducted on 3rd-6th January 2023 in which the teams were required to submit their case study on the given topic to test the business acumen on various parameters. (III) Final Round: 10 teams were given an opportunity to give the presentation of their case
   Study. This round was completely held in an offline format on College Campus on 11th January 2023. Ms. Antara(Consultant at BCG) was the hon'ble judge for the event. Team
   Trailblazers(from SRCC) & Team Fab 2(from LSR) were the winner & runner-up respectively.
   Team Trailblazers was given a cash prize of rs. 2000/- & various exciting coupons, while, Team
   Fab 2 was awarded with a cash price of rs. 1000/- & exciting Coupons. Without a doubt, The event was a huge success & gained a lot of recognition.

#### **FUN FIESTA: A FUN EVENT**

This was a momentous event that was to provide all college students a break from their busy life. extracurricular activities play a vital role. These activities, during college life, keep you positive, fresh, and energetic and go a long way in making you more productive. Not only do they lighten your mood, but they also help in shaping your overall personality and interpersonal skills. This event was conducted in offline mode on **12th January**, **2023** with nearly 70+ participants in the fun event. We had one main event with three subsequent rounds.



#### **MINI GAMES**


Mini Games were also organized into three games.
